

Volunteer of the Year Award

The CFGV Volunteer of the Year Award was established to recognize the dedication of community members who meet community needs in Crested Butte, Gunnison and the upper Gunnison watershed through outstanding service to a nonprofit organization. The nonprofit of the recipient's choice will receive a grant of \$1000.

Each year, the CFGV will recognize one individual who has made a significant contribution to the community in the last year. The recipient will be a full- or part-time resident of Gunnison County who has demonstrated outstanding service and volunteerism on behalf of a community organization.

Nominees should not have received any compensation for their volunteer work, and last year's recipients may not be nominated.* The award will be made at the Annual Grants Award Ceremony in July.

Nominations will be accepted from nonprofit organizations in the form of a letter including the name, address, and telephone number of the nominee; the nominating organization's name; the name of the individual preparing the nomination; and should address the following points:

- What is the mission of your organization?
- Describe the scope of the individual's work, using specific examples of how the work furthered the mission of the nominating organization and of the personal commitment and amount of time and talent contributed.
- How has the individual helped meet a community need in helping your organization?

The CFGV will accept only one application per nonprofit organization.
